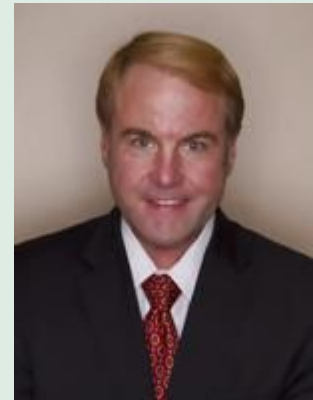
Kamal Malhotra, RN, MBA, President and Co-Founder
